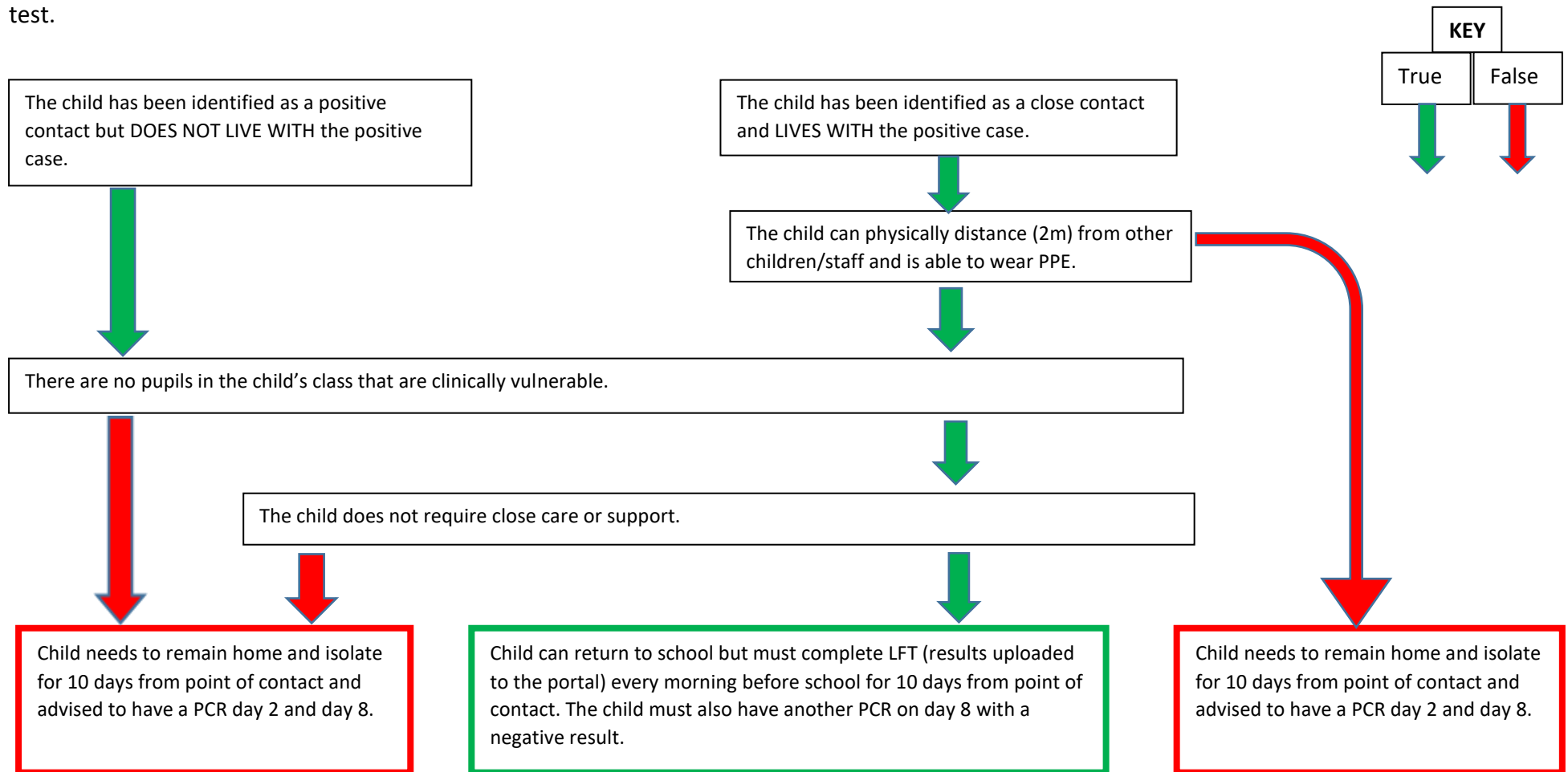


Updated Risk Assessment – Managing safe return of pupils to Greenfield School following a close contact with a positive Covid 19 case – October 2021

A pupil that has been identified as a close contact must remain home and take a PCR test on day 2 following the contact, if the result is NEGATIVE use the flow chart below to assess the risk of their return to school. If a pupil is living with someone who is waiting for a PCR test result we ask that they remain home until a negative PCR result is received, if the result is positive then consider the child as a close contact and arrange a PCR test.



**Please note that if your child is under the age of 5 years old they should not take COVID-19 tests unless directed to do so by a doctor or if you believe a test is absolutely necessary and in the best interests of your child. They should however remain off school whilst they have symptoms.*
