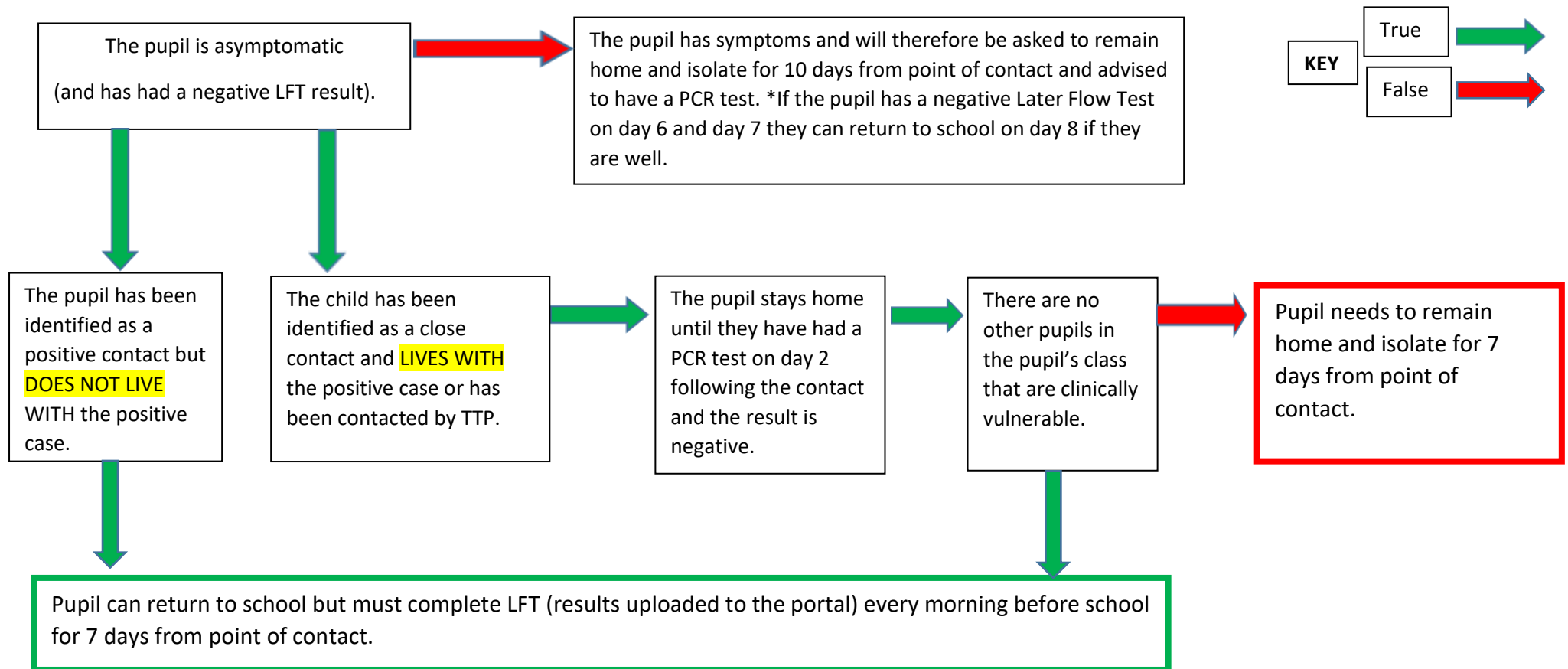


Risk Assessment – Managing safe return of pupils to Greenfield School following contact with a positive Covid 19 case – updated 10.01.22.

Where there have been a contact with someone who has tested positive for Covid 19 (via a PCR or a LFT) a negative LFT result is required before returning to school. Although Welsh Government guidance no longer asks for asymptomatic children to take a PCR, in Greenfield we require a PCR test to be carried out following a close contact within the home or if identified by TTP to keep our medically vulnerable pupils as safe as possible.

If your child is under the age of 5 years old they should not take PCR tests unless directed to do so by a doctor or if you believe a test is absolutely necessary and in the best interests of your child. **They should however remain off school whilst they have symptoms.** They can return to school once they are well but must take a Lateral Flow Test every day for 7 days. If the child cannot tolerate a Lateral Flow Test then they must remain home for the full 7 days.



*If your child has been in contact with another pupil in their class who has tested positive we will inform you and will ask that your child carries out daily LFTs for 7 days following the contact. If there are increasing numbers of positives within the same class we may ask that you take your child for a PCR test.
